Lessons from an Unnamed Leper for those Seeking to develop an Attitude of Thanksgiving:

Luke 17:11-19

1. The _____ of the Ten.

A. The Circumstances

Luke 17:11–12, NASB95 - ¹¹ While He was on the way to Jerusalem, He was passing between Samaria and Galilee. ¹² As He entered a village, ten leprous men who stood at a distance met Him;

B. The Cry

<u>Luke 17:13, NASB95</u> - ¹³ and they raised their voices, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"

C. The Command

Luke 17:14, NASB95 - ¹⁴ When He saw them, He said to them, "<u>Go</u> and show yourselves to the priests..."

D. The Cleansing

Luke 17:14, NASB95 - ¹⁴ When He saw them, He said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they were going, they were cleansed.

2. The of the One.

A. Why He Comes

Luke 17:15–16, NASB95 - ¹⁵ Now one of them, when he saw that he had been healed, turned back, glorifying God with a loud voice, ¹⁶ and he fell on his face at His feet, giving thanks to Him. And he was a Samaritan.

B. What He Finds

Luke 17:17–19, NASB95 - ¹⁷ Then Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But the nine—where are they? ¹⁸ "Was no one found who returned to give glory to God, except this foreigner?" ¹⁹ And He said to him, "<u>Stand up and go</u>; your faith has made you well."

Luke 17:19c, YLT 19 ... Your faith has saved you."

Four Truths to Realize

1. We, too, must cry out to Jesus!

Luke 17:13, NASB95 - ¹³ and <u>they raised their voices, saying, "Jesus,</u> Master, have mercy on us!"

2. We, too, must realize what Jesus has done for us!

Luke 17:15, NASB95 - ¹⁵ Now one of them, when he saw that he had been healed....

3. Obedience always precedes God's Blessings!

Luke 17:14, NASB95 - ¹⁴ When He saw them, He said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And <u>as they were going, they were cleansed.</u>

4. Gratitude is a decision and an action!

Luke 17:15–16, NASB95 - ¹⁵ Now one of them, when he saw that he had been healed, turned back, glorifying God with a loud voice, ¹⁶ and he fell on his face at His feet, giving thanks to Him.
