

A. The "Law" CANNOT and WILL NOT save us.

STUDE VERSE SECTION - Exodus 20:3, NASB95 - "You shall have no [Heb. "absolute imperfect verb" denoting 'an habitual action still in progress"] other <u>gods</u> [Heb: אַלהִים "El-o-heim" a god who is worshipped, used here in the plural without an article] <u>before</u> [lit., before my face meaning "have no other gods 'in my presence'"] Me.

1. The Assertion—*There is* God!

**Exodus 20:1–2, NASB95** - <sup>1</sup> Then <u>God spoke all these words</u>, saying, <sup>2</sup> "<u>I am the LORD your God</u>, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.

2. The Prohibition—There is only \_\_\_\_\_ God!

**Exodus 20:3, NASB95** - "You shall have no other gods before Me.

3. The Invitation—*He is to be* God!

**Exodus 20:3, NLT** - <sup>3</sup> "You must not have any other god but me.

## Life Application Section

1. God deserves our undivided attention.

**Exodus 20:1–2, GNB** - <sup>1</sup> <u>God spoke, and these were his words</u>: <sup>2</sup> "I am the LORD your God who brought you out of Egypt, where you were slaves.

2. God desires our undivided affection.

**Exodus 20:1–3, MSG** - <sup>1</sup> GOD spoke all these words: <sup>2</sup> <u>I am GOD, your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt</u>, out of a life of slavery. <sup>3</sup> No other gods, only me.

3. God demands our undivided allegiance.

**Exodus 20:3, NCV** - <sup>3</sup> "You must not have any other gods except me.
