

STUDE VERSE SECTION - Exodus 20:4, NASB95 - "You shall not [Heb. "absolute imperfect verb" denoting 'an habitual action still in progress'] make for yourself an idol [Heb. לְּפֶּׁלֶּס, "pass-el" is a pagan or material effigy that is worshipped in place of or in lieu of a deity; it's not condemning a symbol] Or any likeness [Heb. תְּמוּנָה "ta-moo-NAH" is a visual appearance of someone or something] of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth.

1. A created idol limits worship.

Exodus 20:4, NASB95 - 4 "You shall not <u>make for yourself</u> an idol..." **Jeremiah 10:14, GNB** - Those who make idols are disillusioned because the gods they made are false and lifeless.

2. A created idol leads to _____ worship.

Exodus 20:4, NLT - ⁴ "You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind <u>or an image of anything</u> in the heavens or on the earth or in the sea.

Deuteronomy 32:21, NKJV - ²¹ They have provoked Me to jealousy by what is not God; <u>They have moved Me to anger by their foolish</u> idols.

3. The Creator God liberates _____ worship.

Exodus 20:5–6, NASB95 - ⁵ "You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me, ⁶ but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.
