STUDY VERSE SECTION - Hebrews 11:39–40, NASB95 - 39 And all these

[people mentioned in this chapter who led their lives by faith and are now cheering us on in our own lives], having gained approval through their faith, did not receive what was

promised [the promise referred to, of course, is the central promise of the Book of Hebrews—that Jesus Christ, who is better than the angels, Moses, Joshua, and the Hebrew High priests, made a perfect sacrifice and established a perfect covenant, ensuring that the old sacrificial system (works) is obsolete and that faith alone in Christ is the only way to live and be saved], **Decause God had provided something better for us [Christ lives in us], so that apart from us [lit., before us] they would not be made perfect [the heroes of faith who preceded us didn't experience the perfection or the maturity we enjoy in the New Covenant with Jesus Christ (or, didn't, until they made it to heaven); They could be made perfect only as Christians are today, that is by Jesus Himself and His sacrifice].

If those on whom the great light of grace had not yet shone showed such surpassing constancy in bearing their ills, what effect ought the full glory of the gospel to have on us? A tiny spark of light led them to heaven, but now that the Son of righteousness shines on us what excuse shall we offer if we still cling to the earth?"

Hebrews 11:39–40, NASB95 - ³⁹ And all these, having gained approval through their faith, did not receive what was promised, ⁴⁰ because God had provided something better for us, so that apart from us they would not be made perfect.

1. The Past

Hebrews 11:39–40, TLB -³⁹ And these <u>men of faith</u>, though they trusted God and won his approval, none of them received all that God had promised them; ⁴⁰ for God wanted them to wait and share the even better rewards that were prepared for us.

They—by faith—worked without Christ in them.

2. The Present

Hebrews 11:39-40, PME - All these won a glowing testimony to their faith, but they did not then and there receive the fulfilment of the promise. <u>God had something better planned for our day</u>, and <u>it was not His plan that they should reach perfection without us.</u>

We-by faith-work with Christ in us.
