# MAN'S INSUFFICIENCY

## 1. God distresses the \_\_\_\_\_

**Daniel 2:1–3, NASB95** - <sup>1</sup> Now in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar, [the first world leader to conquer the entire civilized world]

Nebuchadnezzar had dreams; and his spirit was troubled and his sleep left him. <sup>2</sup> Then the king gave orders to call in the magicians, the conjurers, the sorcerers and the Chaldeans to tell the king his dreams. So they came in and stood before the king. <sup>3</sup> The king said to them, "I had a dream and my spirit is anxious [lit., very deeply disturbed] to understand the dream."

# 2. God disgraces the king's \_\_\_\_\_

Daniel 2:4–12, NASB95 - ... <sup>5</sup> The king replied to the Chaldeans, "<u>The command from me is firm</u> [Aramaic: lit., This is not going to change]; if you do not make known to me the dream and its interpretation, you will be torn limb from limb and your houses will be made a rubbish heap... <sup>10</sup> <u>The Chaldeans answered</u> [in Aramaic (until chapter 4)] the king and said, "There is not a man on earth who could declare the matter for the king, inasmuch as no great king or ruler has ever asked anything like this of any magician, conjurer or Chaldean... <sup>12</sup> Because of this the king became indignant and very furious...

## 3. God gives discernment to \_\_\_\_\_

**Daniel 2:14–16, NASB95** - <sup>14</sup> Then Daniel replied with discretion and discernment to Arioch... <sup>15</sup> "For what reason is the decree from the king so urgent?" Then Arioch informed Daniel about the matter. <sup>16</sup> <u>So</u> Daniel went in and requested of the king that he would give him time, in order that he might declare the interpretation to the king.

- C. The Insufficiency of the Human Heart to want to be sufficient. (All the above)
- D. The ONLY solution to Man's Insufficiency is God's Sufficiency. (Daniel)
