## STUDY VERSE SECTION - Matthew 16:18–19, HCSB - 18 And I also say to you

that you are <u>Peter</u> [Gk: Πέτρος (PET-ros), lit., a stone], and on this <u>rock</u> [Gk: πέτρα (PET-ro) lit., a ledge or wall of stone; most scholars believe that this word, "petra," refers NOT to Peter but to his confession, "You are the Messiah (or "the Christ"), the Son of the living God."] <u>I will build My church</u>, and <u>the forces of Hades</u> [both the place and activity of Hell] <u>will not overpower it</u>. <sup>19</sup> <u>I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven</u>, and <u>whatever you bind on earth is already bound in heaven</u>, and <u>whatever you loose on earth is already loosed in heaven</u>." [In the simplest understanding, we are to be in harmony with Heaven/Jesus.]

## Four Statements about The Church Jesus Built:

- 1. Christ OWNS the church.

- 4. Christ EMPOWERS the church.
