- 1. We have been chosen by God the Father.
- 2. We have been made holy by God the Spirit.
- 3. We have been cleansed by the blood of God the Son.

- B. You have complete hope in Christ—He is the source of all hope!

1. The PROOF—It is guaranteed for us by the resurrection of _____.

STUDY VSERSE SECTION - 1 Peter 1:3, NASB95 - 3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy [The Greek word for Mercy indicates that God did something for us that we did not deserve] has caused [which gives us our word for "heir"] us to be born again [first birth is physical; second is spiritual] to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead...

Titus 3:5, NASB95 - ⁵ <u>He saved us</u>, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy...

2. The PERMANENCE—It is kept in heaven for us.

STUDY VERSE SECTION - 1 Peter 1:4, NASB95 - 4 ...to obtain an inheritance which is imperishable [i.e., permanent] and undefiled [lit.., unstained by sin] and will not fade away, reserved in heaven for you...

Ephesians 1:13–14, NIV84 - ¹³ ... Having believed, you were <u>marked</u> in Him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, ¹⁴ who is a deposit <u>guaranteeing our inheritance</u> until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of His glory.

3. The POWER—God's mighty power assures us that we will safely arrive in
