Why can we Trust in the Bible?

Because, (based on 2 Peter 1:16-21) it is a reliable collection of historical documents written down by eyewitnesses during the lifetime of other eyewitnesses that report to us supernatural events that took place in fulfillment of specific prophecies; they claimed that their writings were divine, rather than human in origin!

TODAY'S STUDY SECTION

STUDY VERSE SECTION - 2 Peter 2:1–3, NASB95 - 1 But [in contrast to what was said in w. 16-21] false prophets [Gk: ψευδοπροφήτης (psudo-pro-PHA-tas) is a deliberately deceptive person pretending to be a prophet (used here in the plural form)] also [slowly] arose among the people, just as there will also be false teachers [Gk: ψευδοδιδάσκαλος (psudo-do-DASK-ka-las) is a deliberately deceptive person deliberately teaching a false doctrine (used here in the plural form)] among you, who will secretly introduce [a word meaning "gently" or "calmly" bringing in a teaching] destructive [lit. to cause so much damage that it cannot be repaired] heresies [gives us our word "schism"], even denying the Master who bought them, bringing swift

destruction upon themselves. ² Many will follow their <u>sensuality</u> [lit. one who engages in sensual pleasure unrestrained by morality], and because of them the way of the truth will be <u>maligned</u> [lit. stinks of an odor]; ³ and in their greed they will exploit you with false [Gk: πλαστός (plas-tos)] words; their <u>judgment</u> [lit. a pronouncement of judgment] from long ago is not idle, and their destruction is not asleep.

Three Thoughts about these Counterfeit Christians

1. Their Message

2 Peter 2:1, NLT - ¹ But there were also false prophets in Israel, just as there will be false teachers among you. They will cleverly teach destructive heresies and even deny the Master who bought them. In this way, they will bring sudden destruction on themselves.

- Today, there are false prophets among us.
- Today, they are trying get us to "deny the Master".

Polycarp told me that the apostle John told him that if any person comes and tells you that Jesus Christ is less than the one-and-only Almighty God, that person is an agent of Satan. - Irenaeus (an early church father)

2. Their Morality

2 Peter 2:2, NLT - ² Many will follow their <u>evil teaching</u> and <u>shameful</u> <u>immorality</u>. And because of these teachers, the way of truth will be slandered.

• They promote a deceptive theology and reckless immorality.

3. Their Method

2 Peter 2:3, NLT - ³ In their greed they will make up clever lies to get hold of your money. But God condemned them long ago, and their destruction will not be delayed.

- 2. False teachers excel at accumulating a larger clientele. v. 2a
- 3. False teachers repel with a terrible smell. v. 2b

- 5. False teachers rebel and will land in hell. v. 3b
