

- 1. The God who created us gave us a singular purpose—to Glorify God!
- 2. We do this by <u>building up those who are saved</u>, <u>reaching out to those who are not</u> <u>saved</u> and <u>praising the One who saves</u>.

Overview of the Book of Romans:

Theme: The Righteousness of God.

Date Written: 56-57 AD.

Author: The Apostle Paul.

Setting: A letter written to the church in Rome while Paul was in Corinth.

**Occasion:** Paul's third missionary journey.

**Key Verses: Romans 1:16–17, HCSB** - <sup>16</sup> For <u>I am not ashamed of the gospel</u>, because it is God's power for salvation to everyone who believes, first to the Jew, and also to the Greek. <sup>17</sup> For <u>in it God's righteousness is revealed</u> from faith to faith, just as it is written: **The righteous will live by faith.** 

#### Basic Outline (Overview): "We Need His Righteousness!"

- Chapters 1-3:20 The Problem of Unrighteousness (All are sinners)
- Chapters 3:21-5:21 The Provision of Righteousness (Jesus Christ)
- Chapters 6-8 The **Power** of Righteousness (Our surrender to Christ)
- Chapters 9—11 The **Promise** of Righteousness (Believers are declared "righteous" while Israel is promised "righteousness.")
- Chapters 12—16 The **Pattern** of Righteousness (His presence in us transforms us. What is true in a person's heart will show up in their life. Signs of righteousness: yielding to God, submitting to authority, loving one's neighbor, bearing other's burdens & serving diligently.)

#### The Gospel and God's Righteousness

- 1. The gospel is powerful! "It is the power of God at work."
- 2. The gospel is simple! "[This is] God at work!"
- 3. The gospel is universal! "[It's God]...saving everyone who believes."

4. The gospel is vital! "God's righteousness [which we need] is revealed."

# The Simple Gospel

#### 1. Christ loves you!

**Romans 5:8, HCSB** -<sup>8</sup> But <u>God proves His own love for us</u> in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us!

**Romans 8:38–39, NASB95** - <sup>38</sup> For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, <sup>39</sup> nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

#### 2. You have sinned!

**Romans 3:10, HCSB** - <sup>10</sup> as it is written: <u>There is no one righteous, not</u> <u>even one</u>.

**Romans 3:23, HCSB** - <sup>23</sup> For <u>all have sinned</u> and fall short of the glory of God.

## 3. Christ died for your sins!

**Romans 5:8, HCSB** - <sup>8</sup> But God proves His own love for us in that while we were still sinners, <u>Christ died for us</u>!

John 3:16, NASB95 -<sup>16</sup> "For God so loved the world, that <u>He gave His</u> <u>only begotten Son</u>, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

## 4. You must surrender to Christ!

**Romans 10:9–10, HCSB** -<sup>9</sup> If you <u>confess with your mouth, "Jesus is</u> Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, <u>you will be saved</u>. <sup>10</sup> One believes with the heart, resulting in righteousness, and one confesses with the mouth, resulting in salvation.

## 5. You can't be saved any other way!

**Romans 6:23, HCSB** -<sup>23</sup> For the wages of sin is death, <u>but the gift of</u> <u>God is eternal life</u> in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**Ephesians 2:8–9, NASB95** -<sup>8</sup> For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that <u>not of yourselves, it is the gift of God</u>; <sup>9</sup> not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

## 6. You *must* make Jesus your Lord today!

**Romans 10:13, NASB95** - <sup>13</sup> for "WHOEVER WILL CALL ON THE NAME OF THE LORD WILL BE SAVED."
