In our 11:00 AM service, we offer more contemporary music. These are more of the worship songs that you may have hear on Christian Radio.



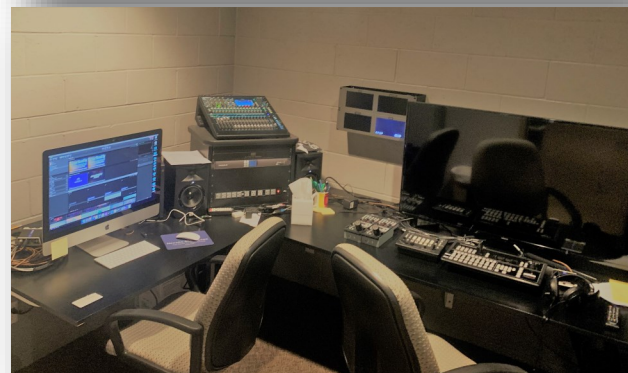
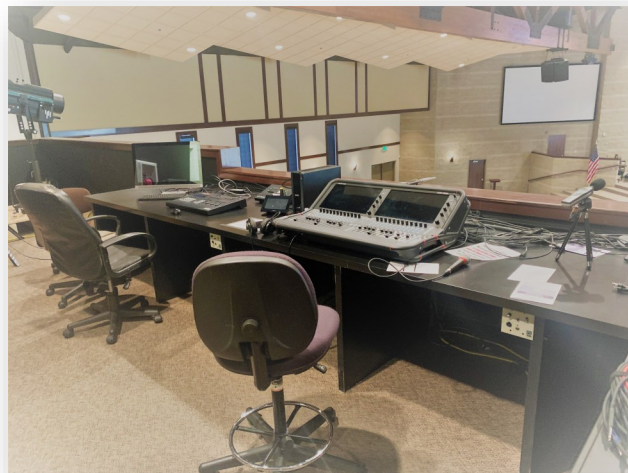

Quality acrylic donated yarn is available for all projects. Come join us!



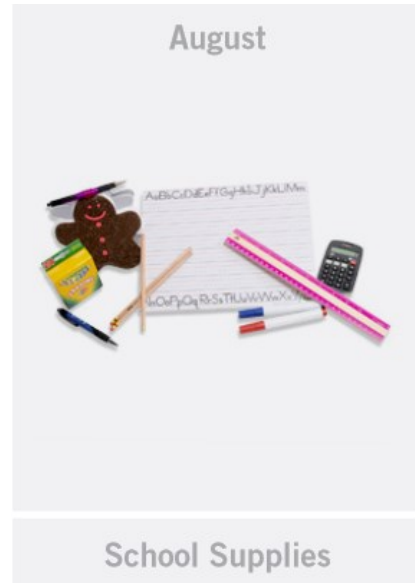
## Operation Christmas Child Update
