Thank you for all the awesome support in honor of Linda Musselman. On behalf of South Reno Baptist Church, Dave and Cindy Strege delivered a check for \$10,000 to Samaritan's Purse Headquarters in Wilkesboro, North Carolina, on June 8. This gift in honor and memory of Linda will last as an enduring and practical blessing to many people in Haut Uele Province of The Democratic Republic of the Congo in Africa. Linda Musselman really had a strong desire for the Women's Ministry Team to fundraise enough money to build a well in Africa, so we wanted to make it happen. Along with support from the Elders, we chose Samaritan's Purse to accomplish this task through its WASH (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene) project in Haute Province. We have been informed that this project has already constructed/installed/rehabilitated six water supply points in April and two in May, along with presenting the Gospel to 3,798 individuals. Praise The Lord!!! Samaritan's Purse not only does wonderful work worldwide, but it also walks alongside communities to teach and support them as a follow-up to the projects and shares the Gospel too. Operation Christmas Child

Operation Christmas Child Update

We are excited and pleased to report the official numbers from Operation Christmas Child 2020. Shoeboxes donated worldwide totaled 9,113,853, including 7,809,410 in the U.S with 415,403 built online. In our area of Northern Nevada/Eastern Sierra, we collected 15,645 shoeboxes (1,770 of those built online), an overall increase of 533 from the year before. South Reno Baptist Church accounted for 669 shoeboxes, including 11 online. The shoeboxes we packed were sent to Mexico, hard-to-reach areas of the world, and to Native Americans inside the U.S.

Our goal as a church for 2021 is 700 shoeboxes, including the 300 we again plan to pack at the annual packing party in November. But you don't have to wait until then to participate in OCC. You can collect your items throughout the year and bring them to SRBC when we begin collecting boxes!

Thank you all for participating in Operation Christmas Child, for being the hands and feet of Jesus and helping others learn about "The Greatest Gift" ever. To God be the glory!!!
