Hebrews 9:15, NLT -¹⁵ That is why [Christ] is the one who mediates a new covenant between God and people, so that all who are called can receive the eternal inheritance God has promised them. For Christ died to set them free from the penalty of the sins they had committed under that first covenant.

1. "It's important that everyone knows that I'm so much more than the bad things that happen to me."
2. "Life doesn't always give breaks to those that deserve it—but we knew that already."
