## A. Job's Response to Zophar

Then Job answered and said....-v.1

# 1. I am completely equal with you. (vv. 1-3)

Job 12:1–3, MSG - <sup>1</sup> Job answered: <sup>2</sup> "I'm sure you speak for all the experts, and when you die there'll be no one left to tell us how to live. <sup>3</sup> But don't forget that I also have a brain— I don't intend to play second fiddle to you. It doesn't take an expert to know these things.

## 2. I am falsely accused by you. (vv. 4-12)

**Job 12:4–5, NLT** - <sup>4</sup> <u>Yet my friends laugh at me</u>, for I call on God and expect an answer. I am a just and blameless man, <u>yet they laugh at me</u>. <sup>5</sup> People who are at ease <u>mock those in trouble</u>. They give a <u>push</u> to people who are stumbling.

### 3. I have this argument for you. (vv. 13-25)

Only God is all-knowing and all-powerful!

**Job 12:13, NLT** - <sup>13</sup> "But true wisdom and power are found in God; counsel and understanding are his.

**Job 12:13, TLB** - <sup>13</sup> But <u>true wisdom and power are God's</u>. He alone knows what we should do; only he understands.

**Job 12:13, MSG** - <sup>13</sup> "True wisdom and real power belong to God; from him we learn how to live, and also what to live for.

### Job points to the wisdom and power of God:

- A. If He tears a thing apart—it cannot be rebuilt.
- B. If He captures a man—he cannot be released.
- C. If He holds back water—it will dry up.
- D. If He sends water—it will overflow the earth.
- E. Wisdom and power belong to Him—all must answer to Him.
- F. He is wiser than the wise—He can make the seemingly wise, fools.
- G. Those who think they have power He can make lowly.
- H. He strips religious leaders of their robes and office.
- I. He takes away the ability to speak of what we thought was wise.
- J. He will put to shame those who think they are mighty/righteous.
- K. He will expose even the darkest corners of everyone's life.
- L. He makes nations great or will bring them low.
- M. He takes away understanding that people stumble over themselves.
- N. He is the eternal light without Him there is nothing but darkness.

### B. God's Power and Wisdom

C. H Spurgeon: Job's message to his friends was clear: "I do know God and how great and wise He is. Don't criticize me on this point any longer." Job says...

I know God's power and wisdom over physical things.

I know God's power and wisdom over men.

I know God's power and wisdom over their thoughts.

I know God's power and wisdom over their rulers.

I know God's power and wisdom over <u>their eloquence</u>.

I know God's power and wisdom over <u>their darkness</u>.

I know God's power and wisdom over all nations.

"God alone can *create*, and God alone can *destroy*. Nothing can be *annihilated* but by the same Power that *created* it. This is a most remarkable fact. No power, skill, or cunning of man can annihilate the smallest particle of matter. Man, by chemical agency, may change its *form*; but to reduce it to *nothing* belongs to God alone." (Dr. H. De Cruz)
