A. Job's Personal 'Declaration of Hope'

1. Life before Death. (vv. 1-6)

Job 14:1, TLB - ¹ "How <u>frail</u> is man, how <u>few his days</u>, how <u>full of</u> trouble!"

Job 14:1, MSG - "We're all adrift in the same boat: too few days, too many troubles."

2. Life after Death. (vv. 7-14)

Job 14:14, NASB95 - ¹⁴ "If a man dies, will he live again? All the days of my struggle <u>I will wait Until my change comes</u>."

Job 14:14, YLT - ¹⁴ If a man dies—does he revive? All days of my warfare I wait, then my change will come."

Job 13:15–16, NCV - ¹⁵ "Even if God kills me, <u>I have hope in him</u>... ¹⁶ This is my salvation."

"It's one thing to 'have hope,' it's another thing to 'declare hope."

B. What the Bible has to Say about "The Blood of Jesus"

Hebrews 9:12–15, NLT - ¹² <u>With His own blood</u>—not the blood of goats and calves—He entered the Most Holy Place once for all time and secured our redemption forever. ¹³ Under the old system, the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer could cleanse people's bodies from ceremonial impurity. ¹⁴ Just think how much more the blood of Christ will purify our consciences from sinful deeds so that we can worship the living God. For by the power of the eternal Spirit, <u>Christ offered himself to God as a perfect sacrifice for our sins</u>. ¹⁵ That is why He is the One who mediates a new covenant between God and people, <u>so that all who are called can receive the eternal inheritance God has promised them</u>. For <u>Christ died to set them free from the penalty of the sins they had committed....</u>

1. The Blood of Jesus saves lost people.

Hebrews 9:12 NLT - ¹² <u>With His own blood</u>—not the blood of goats and calves—<u>He</u> entered the Most Holy Place once for all time and <u>secured our redemption</u>...

2. The Blood of Jesus secures eternal life.

Hebrews 9:12 NLT - ¹² With His own blood—not the blood of goats and calves—He entered the Most Holy Place once for all time and secured our redemption forever.

3. The Blood of Jesus cleanses our vilest sin.

Hebrews 9:14, KJV 1769 - ¹⁴ How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, <u>purge your vilest sins from dead works</u> to serve the living God?

4. The Blood of Jesus transforms the vilest sinner.

Hebrews 9:14, NIV - ¹⁴ How much more, then, will the blood of Christ...cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!

5. The Blood of Jesus <u>ensures</u> our home in Heaven.

Hebrews 9:15, NLT - ¹⁵ That is why He is the One who mediates a new covenant between God and people, so that all who are called can receive the eternal inheritance God has promised them...
