#### A. Job 18 (Bildad Rebukes Job a Second Time—This Time With Fear)

### Bildad: "The Terror of Death for the Wicked"

#### 1. The Dark Life of the Wicked. (vv. 5-6)

Job 18:5–6, NLT - <sup>5</sup> "Surely the <u>light of the wicked will be</u> <u>snuffed out</u>. The sparks of their fire will not glow. <sup>6</sup> The light in their tent will grow dark. The lamp hanging above them will be quenched.

#### 2. The Dangerous Path of the Wicked. (vv. 7-10)

Job 18:7–9, NLT -<sup>7</sup> <u>The confident stride of the wicked will be shortened</u>. Their own schemes will be their downfall. <sup>8</sup> The wicked walk into a <u>net</u>. They fall into a <u>pit</u>. <sup>9</sup> A <u>trap</u> grabs them by the heel. A snare holds them tight.

#### 3. The Dreadful Life of the Wicked. (vv. 11-16)

Job 18:11–14, NLT - 11 "Terrors surround the wicked and trouble them at every step. 12 Hunger depletes their strength,

and calamity waits for them to stumble. <sup>13</sup> Disease eats their skin; death devours their limbs. <sup>14</sup> They are torn from the security of their homes and are brought down to the king of terrors.

#### 4. The Dismal Destiny of the Wicked. (17-21)

Job 18:17–21, NLT - <sup>17</sup> <u>All memory of their existence will fade</u> <u>from the earth, No one will remember their names</u>. <sup>18</sup> They will be thrust from light into darkness, driven from the world... <sup>21</sup> They will say, 'This was the <u>home of a wicked person</u>, the place of one who rejected God.'"

#### B. Some Wrong Theology from Bildad

#### **Bildad made Three Critical Mistakes:**

- 1. He <u>preached to the **wrong man**</u>, for Job was already a believer (Job 1:1, 8).
- 2. He preached with the wrong motive, for there was no love in his heart.
- 3. He preached with the wrong theology.

#### C. Some Right Theology from Jesus

# Jesus: "Three Guiding Principles for the Church" Based on His Words Prior to His Ascension (Luke 24):

## 1. Our Theology Must Be Correct. (vv. 45-46)

Luke 24:45–46, NLT - <sup>45</sup> Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. <sup>46</sup> And he said, "Yes, it was written long ago that the Messiah would suffer and die and rise from the dead on the third day.

#### 2. Our Mission Must Be Clear. (vv. 47-48)

**Luke 24:47–48, NLT** -<sup>47</sup> It was also written that <u>this message</u> would be proclaimed in the authority of His name to all the <u>nations</u>, beginning in Jerusalem: '<u>There is forgiveness of sins</u> for all who repent.' <sup>48</sup> You are witnesses of all these things.

#### 3. Our Advocate Must Be Cherished. (v. 49)

**Luke 24:49, NLT** - <sup>49</sup> "And now I will send the Holy Spirit, just as my Father promised. But stay here in the city until the Holy Spirit comes and fills you with power from heaven."
