A. Job 19 (Job's Response to Bildad)

Job: "Your Words Have Broken My Heart"

1. Job Feels Wronged by His <u>Comforters</u>. (vv. 1-4)

Job 19:1–4, TLB -¹ The reply of Job: ² "How long are you going to trouble me, and try to <u>break me with your words</u>? ³ <u>Ten times</u> [Probably a figure of speech meaning "again and again" you have used the power of your words to crush me] now you have declared I am a sinner. Why aren't you ashamed to deal with me so harshly?

2. Job Feels Wronged by <u>God</u>. (vv. 5-12)

Job 19:5–13, NLT - …⁶ But it is <u>God who has wronged me</u>, capturing me in his net. ⁷ "I cry out, 'Help!' but no one answers me. I protest, but there is no justice. ⁸ God has blocked my… He has plunged my path into darkness. ⁹ He has stripped me of my honor and removed the crown from my head. ¹⁰ He has demolished me on every side, and I am finished. He has uprooted my hope like a fallen tree. ¹¹ His fury burns against me; he counts me as an enemy.

3. Job Feels Wronged by His <u>Family and Friends</u>. (vv. 13-20)

Job 19:13–20, NLT - ¹³ "<u>My relatives stay far away, and my friends</u> <u>have turned against me</u>. ¹⁴ My family is gone, and my close friends have forgotten me...¹⁷ My breath is repulsive to my wife. I am rejected by my own family...¹⁹ <u>My close friends detest me. Those I</u> <u>loved have turned against me</u>. ²⁰ I have been reduced to skin and <u>bones and have escaped death by the skin of my teeth</u> [an idiom was first spoken by Job; Other quotes by Job: "The Lord gives, and the Lord takes away." (Job 1:21); "Naked Lame into this world and naked 'Il leave (Job 1:21)]

4. Job Knows He is <u>Right With God</u>. (vv. 23-27)

Job 19:23–27, NLT - ²³ "Oh, that my words could be recorded. Oh, that they could be inscribed on a monument, ²⁴ carved with an iron chisel and filled with lead, engraved forever in the rock. ²⁵ "But as for me, <u>I know that my Redeemer lives</u>, and <u>he will stand upon the earth at last</u>. ²⁶ And <u>after my body has decayed</u>, yet <u>in my body I will see God!</u> ²⁷ <u>I will see him for myself</u>. Yes, <u>I will see him with my own eyes</u>. <u>I am overwhelmed at the thought!</u>

B. The Power of Our Words (James 3:1-12)

"The <u>tongue is a small thing</u>, but what <u>enormous damage it can do</u>." - James 3:5 "<u>Death and life</u> and in the <u>power of the tongue</u>." - Proverbs 18:21

- 1. Our Words have the **Power to Direct**. (vv. 1-4)
- 2. Our Words have the <u>Power to Destroy</u>. (vv. 5-8)
- 3. Our Words have the **Power to Deliver**. (vv. 9-12)

C. Powerful Words to Encourage All of Us

Job 19:25–27, NLT - ²⁵ "But as for me, <u>I know that my Redeemer lives</u>, and he will <u>stand upon the earth at last</u>. ²⁶ And after my body has decayed, yet in my body I will see God! ²⁷ <u>I will see him for myself</u>. Yes, <u>I will see him</u> with my own eyes. I am overwhelmed at the thought!

*<u>WORD STUDY</u>: **Redeemer** - Heb. **'>X**; (Gaw-al) – lit., a blood avenger; This type avenger would not seek 'revenge,' but 'justice.' "In <u>civil matters</u>, the avenger would become a '*redeemer* (ie., buying back) of what was lost.' In <u>criminal</u> <u>matters</u>, the avenger would become an '*advocate* of one falsely accused— Seeking the acquittal of the suffering one falsely accused.'
