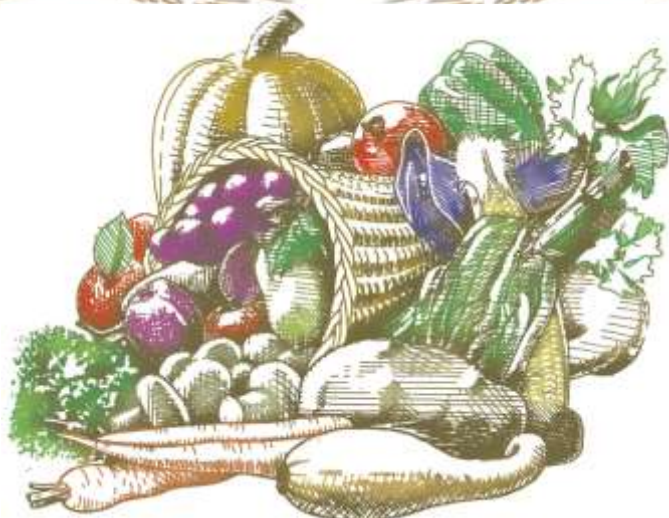

Prayer Groups for our Missionaries

The Missions Committee would like to involve the congregation in supporting our missionaries through prayer and communication. To accomplish this goal we want to establish a system of having Missionary Representatives who would agree to communicate directly with a given missionary to discuss their current activities and needs, to be better able to pray effectively for them. This representative (or representative couple) would lead a group of volunteers in a monthly prayer group for their specific missionary. The representative would be responsible to submit a short report (a paragraph or two) to the Missions Team of the missionary's activities, needs, and prayer requests.



A Missionary Rep would be required to:

- Establish a means of communication with a specific missionary
- Learn of the missionary's current activities
- Determine physical and prayer needs
- Host a monthly prayer meeting
- Submit a monthly report to the Missions Team
