Philippians 1:6, NASB - ⁶ For I [Paul] <u>am confident</u> [lit., since I am confident] Of this very thing, that He [lit., The He or The One—and no other agency] who <u>began</u> [Gk: ἐνάρχομαι, (en-air-cho-my) gives us our Eng. word "inaugurate"] a good work in you will <u>perfect</u> [lit., continue—keep going until it's finished. "This 'work' is a decisive, deliberate, planned and executed to perfection work." -ATR] it until the day of Christ Jesus [returns to Earth].

Philippians 1:6, NIV - ⁶ being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
