Part Two - Philippians 2:8-11



<u>Before</u> the Incarnation, Jesus Christ did not cling to His rights as God. (vv. 5-6) <u>During</u> the Incarnation, Jesus Christ laid aside His life and His Glory (v. 7) <u>After</u> the Incarnation, Jesus Christ was exalted by God-the-Father (vv. 9-11)

#### Message Section

#### 1. What Jesus \_\_\_\_\_\_.

**Philippians 2:6, NLT** -<sup>6</sup> Though <u>he was Go</u>d, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to.

**Philippians 2:6, PME** - <sup>6</sup> For he, who <u>had always been God</u>...did not cling to his privileges as God's equal....

Philippians 2:6, YLT -<sup>6</sup> ... in the exact essence and form of God....

## 2. What Jesus \_

**Philippians 2:7–8, NLT** -<sup>7</sup> Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and <u>was born as a human being</u>.

#### 3. What Jesus \_\_\_\_\_

**Philippians 2:8, NASB** -<sup>8</sup> Being found in appearance as a man, <u>He</u> <u>humbled Himself</u> by <u>becoming obedient to the point of death</u>, <u>even death on a cross</u>.

## 4. What Jesus \_\_\_\_\_

Philippians 2:9–11, NASB - <sup>9</sup> For this reason also, <u>God highly</u> exalted Him, and <u>bestowed on Him the name which is above</u> every name, <sup>10</sup> so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and <u>that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord</u>, to the glory of God the Father.
