- A. Young Timothy was perhaps Paul's closest friend and companion.
- B. Timothy's name appears in Paul's writings more than anyone else.
- C. He was a native of Lystra (part of modern Turkey).
- D. His mother was Jewish (religious), and his father was Greek (pagan).
- E. Paul led him to Christ during his first missionary journey.
- F. Timothy's mother and grandmother were believers.
- G. He was trained in both Greek and Hebrew.
- H. Paul had him circumcised to better appeal to the Jews.
- I. Timothy was Paul's troubleshooter and messenger to the churches.
- J. At this point, Paul and Timothy had been together for 10 years.
- K. Despite divine calling and spiritual gifts, Timothy had human frailties:
 - 1. Lacked confidence as a youth (1 Tim. 4:12).
 - 2. He was tempted with human passions (1 Tim. 2:21-22).
 - 3. He experienced low points in his personal life (2 Tim. 2:14; 4:2, 5).

To receive a Servant's Honor....

1. We must cultivate a servant's

Philippians 2:19–21, NLT - ¹⁹ If the Lord Jesus is willing, I hope to send Timothy to you soon for a visit. Then he can cheer me up by telling me how you are getting along. ²⁰ I have no one else like Timothy, who genuinely cares about your welfare. ²¹ All the others care only for themselves and not for what matters to Jesus.

A servant's heart puts others ahead of himself for the sake of Jesus.

2. We must endure a servant's _____

Philippians 2:22–24, NASB95 - ²² But you know of <u>his proven</u> worth, that <u>he served with me in the furtherance of the gospel like a child serving his father.</u> ²³ Therefore I hope to send him immediately, as soon as I see how things go with me; ²⁴ and I trust in the Lord that I myself also will be coming shortly.

A servant is willing to be sent <u>anywhere</u>.

A servant is willing to serve <u>anyone</u>.

A servant is willing to sacrifice <u>anything</u>.

2 Timothy 4:8, NLT - ⁸ And now the prize awaits me—the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give me on the day of his return.

Philippians 2:3–4, NASB - ³ <u>Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit</u>, but with humility of mind <u>regard one another as more important than yourselves</u>; ⁴ do not merely <u>look out</u> for your own personal interests, but also for <u>the interests of others</u>.
