**Philippians 3:7–11, NASB95** - <sup>10</sup> that I may know Him [a controlling participial phrase (there is debate whether the word "power" is included in this 'controlling participial phrase'] and the <u>power</u> [Eng. dynamite] of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death; <sup>11</sup> in <u>order that I may</u> attain to the resurrection from the dead.

Philippians 3:10–11, NIV - <sup>10</sup> <u>I want to know Christ</u> and the power of <u>His resurrection</u> and the fellowship of sharing in His sufferings, <u>becoming like Him in his death</u>, <sup>11</sup> and so, somehow, to attain to the resurrection from the dead.

**Philippians 3:10, NLT** - <sup>10</sup> I want to know Christ and experience the mighty power that raised Him from the dead.

**Philippians 3:10, MSG** - <sup>10</sup> I gave up all that inferior stuff so I could know Christ personally, experience his resurrection power, be a partner in his suffering, and go all the way with him to death itself.

## "The Fellowship of His Sufferings" (KJV)

- A. It means that following Christ will not be easy.
- B. It means that I will be called to choose Christ over anything this fallen world has to offer.
- C. It means that I will deal with the 'things of this world' in ways that draw me nearer to Christ and away from the world.
- D. It means that I will always deal with the things of this world in ways that show that my treasure is in Christ—not this world.
- E. It means if I lose any or all of thing things this world can offer, I will not lose my joy in or my relationship with Christ.

**Philippians 3:11, TLB** - <sup>11</sup> So whatever it takes, <u>I will be one who</u> <u>lives in the fresh newness of life of those who are alive from the dead.</u>

**Philippians 3:11, NLT** - <sup>11</sup> so that...<u>I will experience the</u> resurrection from the dead!
