# What Makes a Great Marriage?

- 1. You need two people who are skilled and committed to meeting each other's needs.
- 2. You need two people who are skilled and committed to good communication.
- 3. You need two people who are skilled and committed to resolving conflict.
- 4. You need two people who understand their biblical roles in marriage.
- 5. You need two people who are absolutely committed to each other for life.
- 6. You need God's protection and hand of blessing.
- 7. You need two people who have a workable game plan to facilitate all of the above.

# <u>Section One</u>: Understanding One's Biblical Role in Marriage

**Ephesians 5:21-31, NASB95** - <sup>21</sup> and **be subject to one another in the fear of Christ**. <sup>22</sup> Wives, *be subject* to your own husbands, as to the Lord. <sup>23</sup> For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, He Himself being the Savior of the body. <sup>24</sup> But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives ought to be to their husbands in everything. <sup>25</sup> Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her, <sup>26</sup> so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, <sup>27</sup> that He might present to Himself the church in all her glory, having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she would be holy and blameless. <sup>28</sup> So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself; <sup>29</sup> for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ also does the church, <sup>30</sup> because we are members of His body. <sup>31</sup> For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and shall be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. <sup>32</sup> This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church. <sup>33</sup> Nevertheless, each individual among you also is to <u>love his own</u> wife even as himself, and the wife must see to it that she respects her husband.

Role of a godly Husband The Husband is the <u>Head</u> of the House Provider of the home Protector of the home Primary "need meeter" for the wife Primary significance should come from home Remember, he needs "respect" Role of a godly Wife The Wife is the <u>Heart</u> of the Home Mold and nurture the kids Manage the household Meet needs of the husband Model Christ's Spirit in the home Remember, she needs "love"

# Section Two: Communication within Marriage

## A. Godly Communication in marriage must be prioritized!

### B. Godly Communication skills in marriage must be <u>perfected</u>.

NOTE: Always touch when you talk, use good eye contact, and repeat frequently what you think your mate says.

#### C. Godly Communication in marriage must be planned—THE FAMILY CONFERENCE

<u>NOTE</u>: Each family needs a specific time each week to hold a family conference. Children may also be included, depending on age, at the conclusion of the family conference to communicate important family activities, problem solving, and goals.



# <u>Section Three</u>: Conflict Management within Marriage

The Three Reasons for Conflict in every marriage:

| Reasons<br>Common misunderstandings | Plan of Attack<br>Say, "I'm sorry" begin by expressing how you<br>contributed to the issue and then identify the<br>feelings you cause in your mate. Then, express<br>regret again. |
|-------------------------------------|---|
| Creeping Separateness               | Prioritize "Need meeting" and "Love Languages"<br>and remember that the "battleground" is the<br>calendar and the "to-do-list".   |
| Creeping Resentment                 | Prioritize resolving <i>any</i> resentment you have against your mate in a safe, teachable moment.<br>Seek mutually agreed upon outside help, if needed.                            |

# Section Five: Reaffirming Total Commitment to One Another

**Philippians 2:3-4 [A passage written to the married]** - <sup>3</sup> <u>Do nothing from selfishness</u> or empty conceit, but with humility of mind let each of you <u>regard one another as more important than himself</u>; <sup>4</sup> do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the <u>interests of [the] other</u>.

- 1. Guard against "selfish independence" (The goal of marriage is "unselfish interdependence")
- 2. Commit to being the primary need-meeter in your mate's life-no matter what!
- 3. "Lay down your life for your mate!" Dr. Roy Fish
- 4. Seek to be characterized by predictability, credibility, and transparency—they impart trust.
- 5. Develop rituals that say, "I love you and will be yours forever!"

# Developing the Good Game Plan (Inspiration)

## Remember the practical battleground in marriage is the calendar and the "to-do list!"

## Calendar: "Dialog daily, date weekly, depart monthly"

Weekly escapes become your communication connectors Monthly experiences become your companionship keepers Yearly extravaganza becomes your shared memory makers

- You need a "Family Conference" every week.
- You need a night every week for a "date night"
- You need a night every week for a "family night"
- You also need "bulk" mate time and/or family time every month or so.

## The "To-do List": "Plan your work and work your plan"

Make your plan **M**easurable, **A**ttainable, **P**ersonal, **S**pecific. Develop you plans with "needs" and "love languages" in mind.

# Section Seven: Getting God's Hand of Favor in Your Marriage

## 1. Give Jesus Christ first place in your marriage.

**Matthew 6:33, NLT** - <sup>33</sup> <u>Seek the Kingdom of God above all else</u>, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need.

### 2. Attend Church weekly as a couple.

**Hebrews 10:25, NASB95** - <sup>25</sup>... not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.

### 3. Concentrate on your role in marriage.

**Ephesians 5:21-33, NASB95** - <sup>21</sup> and <u>be subject to one another in the fear of Christ</u>. <sup>22</sup> <u>Wives, be subject to</u> <u>your own husbands</u>, as to the Lord. ... <sup>25</sup> <u>Husbands</u>, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her... <sup>31</sup> For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and shall be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. <sup>32</sup> This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church. <sup>33</sup> Nevertheless, each individual among you also is to <u>love his own wife even as himself, and the wife must see to it that she respects her husband</u>.

### 4. Make sure your words to each other are kind and godly.

**Proverbs 13:3, NASB95** - <sup>3</sup> <u>The one who guards his mouth preserves his life</u>; The one who opens wide his lips comes to ruin.

**Proverbs 25:11, NASB95** - <sup>11</sup> Like apples of gold in settings of silver is a [kind] word spoken in right circumstances.

### 5. Pray daily for each other.

Ephesians 6:18, NASB95 - <sup>18</sup> With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, ...

#### 6. Focus on meeting each other's needs.

**Philippians 2:3-4, NCV** - <sup>3</sup> When you do things, do not let selfishness or pride be your guide. Instead, be humble and give more honor to others than to yourselves. <sup>4</sup> Do not be interested only in your own life, but be interested in the lives of others.

#### 7. Never try to get back at your spouse.

**1 Thessalonians 5:15, NCV** - <sup>15</sup> Be sure that <u>no one pays back wrong for wrong</u>, but always <u>try to do what is</u> good for each other ...

### 8. Decide to make the Lord "first" in your finances.

**2** Corinthians 9:10-11, NLT - <sup>10</sup> For God is the one who provides seed for the farmer and then bread to eat. In the same way, <u>he will provide and increase your resources</u> and then produce a great harvest of <u>generosity in</u> <u>you</u>. <sup>11</sup> Yes, you will be enriched in every way so that you can always be generous. And when we take your gifts to those who need them, they will thank God.

## 9. <u>NEVER</u> consider divorce an option.

**1 Corinthians 7:10-11, NLT** - <sup>10</sup> But for those who are married, I have a command that comes not from me, but from the Lord. <u>A wife must not leave her husband</u>. <sup>11</sup> ... <u>And the husband must not leave his wife</u>.
