“Forget not all His benefits.”

- Psalm 103:2

1. Pardon

Psalm 103:3, NASB -³ *Who pardons all your iniquities....*

Psalm 103:3, NLT -³ *He forgives all my sins....*

2. Healing

Psalm 103:3, NASB -³ *Who pardons all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases;*

Psalm 103:3, NLT -³ *He forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases.*

3. Deliverance

Psalm 103:4, NASB -⁴ *Who redeems your life from the pit....*

Psalm 103:4, NLT -⁴ *He redeems me from death....*



The Pit, under Caiaphas' house where Jesus spent the night before his Crucifixion. The pit consists of a small area with no doors, no windows and no light. Jesus would have been there alone.

4. Coronation

Psalm 103:4, NASB -⁴ *...Who crowns you with lovingkindness and compassion.... [The “Crown” reminds us of our position as the children of God.]*

Psalm 103:4, ESV -⁴ *...who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy....*

Psalm 103:4, TLB -⁴ *He ransoms me from hell. He surrounds me with loving-kindness and tender mercies.*

5. Satisfaction

Psalm 103:5, NASB -⁵ *Who satisfies your years with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle.*

Psalm 103:5, NCV -⁵ *He satisfies me with good things and makes me young again, like the eagle.*
